

## PUBLIC BILLS, RESOLUTIONS, AND MEMORIALS.

Under clause 3 of Rule XXII, bills, resolutions, and memorials were introduced and severally referred as follows:

By Mr. REEDER. A bill (H.R. 30887) fixing the number of Representatives in Congress to which each State shall be entitled under the population shown by the Thirteenth Decennial Census; to the Committee on the Census.

By Mr. CAMPBELL. A bill (H.R. 30894) providing for the apportionment of Representatives in Congress among the several States, under the Thirteenth and subsequent decennial censuses; to the Committee on the Census.
